



Translated as courtyard shelter's, Anganwadi was started under Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) program. We have anganwadi centers at **Madanpur Khadar, Badarpur**.





ANGANWADI'S

Due to COVID lockdown restrictions, SHAPE India distributed Dry Ration kits with similar nutrition content as that of hot cooked meals. Kits were distributed at the Anganwadi Centers to children parents and pregnant/lactating mothers. Home delivery of ration kits was also conducted by Anganwadi teachers.

Our Services

PRE-SCHOOL EDUCATION

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TECHNICAL EDUCATION COMMUNITY OUTREACH SCHEME (TECOS)

Since most of the women in the neighbourhood are unemployed and living in poverty, most of them want to start their own businesses. However, due to the patriarchal family structure, they are unable to leave the area and find employment, and their inability to start their own businesses is hampered by a lack of assistance and technical expertise.

Since 2008, SHAPE India has been implementing this programme with assistance from the GNCT, Delhi's Department of Training & Technical Education.

SHAPE India provides training for marginalized women (South Delhi) on:

- Technical Education : Basic computer training on Microsoft Word, Microsoft Excel, PowerPoint, Internet, GUI of operating system, etc.
- Garment Making : Basic draping technique, Needle Craft, Fashion Accessories, Fabric Analysis, Elements of Art and Design, etc.
- Career Counselling and Personality Development





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STATE URBAN LIVELIHOOD MISSION (SULM)

In order to decrease the poverty and vulnerability of urban poor households, SHAPE India has begun the development of Self-Help Groups under SULM, and GNCT. This is done by giving these households access to chances for gainful selfemployment and wage employment based on skill sets.

In the South East of Delhi, SHAPE India has established 52 Self Help Groups to date, giving its members the chance to pursue self-employment and get skill-based training that would enable them to become independent and self-sufficient.





SUPPLEMENTARY NUTRITION

With the motto of reducing malnutrition, the Supplementary Nutrition Food (SNF) programme provides hot cooked meals or dry ration to Children, Lactating mothers, and pregnant ladies of Anganwadi centres in **South Delhi (Badarpur) and West Delhi (Dabari, ManglaPuri, Mahaveer Enclave)**

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SUPPLEMENTARY NUTRITION

Due to COVID lockdown restrictions, SHAPE India prepared Dry Ration kits with similar nutrition content as that of hot cooked meals. Our kitchens were deep cleaned and our staff followed all the COVID-19 government guidelines.

MAHILA PANCHAYAT

Mahila Panchayat provides a platform for women to raise voice and seek for help when there is any dispute in their lives. It is a place that provides legal advice and counselling.

Panchayat cases are resolved using conversations and social pressure. If the only option left is divorce, the panchayat sends the case to court.

SHAPE India has experience in setting up Mahila panchayats with an innovative and collective approach. We aim at capacity building activities to aware women of their legal rights.

We have Mahila Panchayats set up in the South and South East districts of Delhi.





MAHILA PANCHAYAT

Women empowerment is a process in which women make their own independent decisions. Mahila Panchayat just provides the right information that will help a woman to make informed decisions.

Creating a frictionless environment for women, where they can raise their voice against social violence and atrocities against them.

During COVID lockdowns, SHAPE INDIA continuously worked with victims through phone calls or Whatsapp messages.

How does it work?

BUILD TRUST TREAT ALL VICTIMS EQUALLY

- Make women from marginalised communities aware of their rights
- Build community-level group of volunteers who can assist victims on the spot
- Provide counselling for redressals and legal procedures
- The proactive response towards a case
- Educate women to help them fight the male-dominated society
- Provide a free platform where everyone is the same and anyone can raise their voice to seek help



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MOBILE HELPLINE

The mission of Mobile Helpline is to bring a revolutionary change in controlling crimes against women and creating a society where women can protest against harassment and molestation with courage.

Immediate assistance is provided to women in distress with a 24/7 toll-free helpline number issued by Delhi Government.

SHAPE India has set up its Mobile Helpline service in the North, South and South East districts of Delhi. It helps victims by providing all the necessary support to fight their case starting from filing an FIR to helping them collect evidence.





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MOBILE HELPLINE

A woman is entitled to lead a life full of dignity, respect, and free of fear. But crime against women has been on the rampant rise. Many marginalized women live with a fear of domestic violence, honour killing, acid attacks, and sexual harassment.

Mobile Helpline Number provides a platform for all women to stand against their oppressors, seek help, and fight for their rights.

During COVID lockdowns, SHAPE INDIA continuously worked with victims through phone calls or Whatsapp messages.

How does it work?

24/7 ASSISTANCE

HOME VISITS AND LEGAL HELP

- Provide toll-free 24-hours telecom service to women affected by violence
- Facilitate crisis and non-crisis intervention through referral to the appropriate agencies such as police, DLSA/PO/OSC
- Provide information about the appropriate support services, government schemes and programmes available to the woman affected by violence
- The proactive response towards a case
- Educate women to help them fight the male-dominated society
- Required urgent medical and police assistance to rescue a woman from a violent situation



SELF HELP GROUPS (SHG)

SHGs are built with the mission to eradicate poverty and to make marginalized women financially independent. Each SHG has 10-20 women, usually from similar social and economic backgrounds. It is a holistic programme of micro-enterprises covering all aspects of self-employment.

SHAPE India acts as a facilitator to encourage and create awareness amongst the SHG members. We help SHGs to identify local resources and opportunities. Our role is to promote, nurture, strengthen, and monitor SHGs.

Our SHGs are located in the South East and North West districts of Delhi.



SELF HELP GROUPS (SHG)

Self Help Groups (SHGs) existence is relevant to make the people below the poverty line hopeful and self-reliant. SHGs enable them to increase their income, improve their standard of living and status in society. It acts as a catalyst for bringing this section of society to the mainstream.

Our Sustainable SHGs Approach

FORMATION CRITERIA

REGULAR ELECTIONS

REGULAR TRAININGS

- Selections are made within the mutual likings of the individuals to enhance the essence of the project
- One Member can take part from one family so that more families can join
- The size of the SHGs should be between 8-10 members
- Office bearers are selected via an election process.
- Members should actively participate in the SHG activities
- We follow effective and efficient ways to train our SHG members.
- Training focuses on SHG Orientation, Financial Literacy, health hygiene etc.



PROJECT ABHIMAAN MSM

Members of the MSM (Male Sex Male) group are at high risk to get exposed to HIV. Various factors are responsible for this. Some prominent factors are:

- Biological factors
- Behavioural factors (e.g. inconsistent use of condoms)
- Social and cultural factors

Ganesh Nagar, a district in East Delhi, holds a large population of MSMs in the city. SHAPE India under the Target Intervention (TI) program provides counselling, medical support, and treatment to them.

PROJECT ABHIMAAN MSM

Biological, behavioural, legal, and social and cultural factors put men who have sex with men at higher risk than the general population. Lack of knowledge and awareness about treatment and health care facilities also puts the health of an individual at risk.

Through virtual contact, we have begun to reach more beneficiaries, and we have added two additional staff members for MSM virtual contact.

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PROJECT FATEH

IDU population's lack of knowledge combined with a variety of human rights abuses, social stigma and discrimination exacerbate their risks of acquiring HIV.

Punjab is caught in a vicious circle of drug abuse, the number of drug addicts is increasing day by day.

Fatehgarh Sahib, a district in Punjab, is facing an all-time rise in the number of drug addicts. SHAPE India under the Target Intervention (TI) program provides counselling, medical support, and treatment to them.

Injecting drug users face many problems such as social stigma, lack of job opportunities, depression, lack of healthcare and counselling which drastically affect their confidence. Our team provide counselling and support to the IDUs to help them win back their confidence.

During COVID, our team supported the beneficiaries by providing them with hygiene kits, dry ration kits and hot cooked meals.

People who exchange sex for money are more vulnerable to HIV compared to the general population. Many factors increase the risk.

- Social and legal factors
- Multiple partners and inconsistent condom use

Amritsar, a city in Punjab, holds a large population of female sex workers. SHAPE India under the Target Intervention (TI) program provides counselling, medical support, and treatment to them.

PROJECT - NAI DISHA

Punjab has one of the country's largest HIV epidemics. SHAPE India along with Punjab State Aids Control Society Chandigarh is implementing the Link Worker Scheme in **Faridkot**, **Punjab from January 2021**

Our goal is to reach High-Risk Groups (HRGs), vulnerable men and women with information, knowledge and skills on HIV/STI prevention and risk reduction.

Our Goal

- The scheme aims at reaching out to rural populations who are vulnerable and are at risk of HIV/AIDS in a non-stigmatised enabling environment.
- The scheme aims at improving linkage to other social and health benefits provided by other line departments in line with local norms, regulations suitable for vulnerable populations.
- To find out PLHIV in our registered population by testing all HRGs twice a year and put all HRGs found positive on ART Treatment as soon as possible.
- Comprehensive care, support and treatment to all persons living with HIV/AIDS
- Increase awareness among the general population, particularly women and youth.




PROJECT - NAI DISHA

Highlights of the Project

The primary focus in this kind of model will be to address both high-risk groups and vulnerable populations. The saturation of high-risk population coverage is a priority. Following target populations have been identified for coverage under intensive intervention:

- High-Risk Groups (FSW, MSM, IDU) and their partners
- People Living with HIV (PLHIV) and their spouses especially discordant couples Most at risk adolescence (MARA)
- Most at-risk youth
- Migrants and their spouses
- Truckers and their spouses
- Woman/Child headed households
- Children affected by AIDS (CABA)
